

Jackrabbit and Track Attack Passes - 2020

On the first day of Jackrabbits/Track Attack, you will receive a Jackrabbit/Track Attack Ski Pass for your child and a Jackrabbit/Track Attack Vehicle Pass for your car. The cost of these passes is included in your registration fee.

The **Jackrabbit/Track Attack Ski Pass** allows your child to be on Arrowhead Park trails during his/her lesson only. *It should be kept in your child's coat pocket.*

The **Jackrabbit/Track Attack Vehicle Pass** lets you enter Arrowhead Park and park for the duration of your child's lesson. *It must be displayed on your car's dash.* It does not allow parents to ski, or enter the park at any other time.

If you wish to ski in the park while your child is at lessons, you must purchase an **Adult Daily Ski Pass** (\$15) for yourself or an **Adult Season Ski Pass** (\$150) for one adult.

Some families ski at the park many times over the winter and purchase a **Family Season Ski Pass** (\$360). If you purchase a Family Season Ski Pass (or a Youth Season Ski Pass for your child), then your kids do not need Jackrabbit/Track Attack passes. We will reimburse you the fee (\$28/child) that we pay to the park for your child's JR/TA pass. A board member will be at your practice in early January to give refunds to anyone who has purchased a Family Season Ski Pass. If you choose this option, Please have your child's Season Ski Pass with you as proof of purchase. You will need to purchase your Family Ski Pass *before Jan 6* from the park office.

Should you purchase an **Adult Park Season Ski Pass** for yourself or just pay each time you come? If you only plan to ski when your child is in lessons, then it might be cheaper to just purchase a daily ski pass each day. (\$15 per day vs. \$150 for the Season Ski Pass) However, there are two reasons why you might want to consider a Season Ski Pass. First is the convenience of not having to stop at the park office each Saturday and stand in line. Secondly, your **Season Ski Pass** includes a **Winter Vehicle Permit** which allows you to park your vehicle in the park while you are skiing. IN ADDITION, the **Winter Vehicle Pass** also allows you to bring a carload of people into the park to use the tubing hill, snowshoe trails, and skating trail (all activities except skiing). It also allows you to use the facilities in Algonquin Park for the winter. (A vehicle permit is normally \$18 per week day/ \$21 for weekend day if you bring your family in for the day to skate, snowshoe and tube.)

Should you purchase a **Family Season Ski Pass**? If you plan to ski with your child on other days, you might want to purchase a family ski pass for \$360. If you do purchase a Family Season Ski Pass, the club will refund you \$28 from your child's program fees as mentioned above. So if you have 2 adults and two kids in Track Attack or Jackrabbits, you would pay \$360 for the Family Season Ski Pass and receive a refund of \$56. So the net cost of the pass would be \$304. The cost of two adult Season Ski Passes is \$300 (\$150 x 2,) so you are not paying much more to purchase the Family Season Ski Pass, and your family can ski as often as you wish, as well as snowshoe, tube and skate. (Note that ARC fees do NOT include a Jackrabbit or Track Attack pass so there is no refund for kids in ARC.)

Vehicle Pass vs. Ski Passes

If you have purchased a year round or winter provincial park vehicle permit., it DOES NOT allow you to ski on the trails. A vehicle permit allows you to walk, snowshoe, tube and skate in the park and covers everyone in your vehicle for these activities. If you want to ski in the park, you must purchase a ski pass for each individual who wishes to ski. If you already have an Annual Vehicle Permit or a Winter Vehicle Permit, you can turn it in and upgrade to either an Adult or a Family Season Ski Pass and receive the value of the winter vehicle permit off your Ski Pass.
